The U.S. Trade and Development Agency (USTDA) is sponsoring a Reverse Trade Mission (RTM) for a delegation of senior officials from Kazakhstan's Ministry of Oil and Gas, KazTransGaz, KazMunaiGas (KMG) and NIPi Neftegas.

The goal of this RTM is to familiarize key decision makers with U.S. solutions and equipment in gas utilization, including:

- Gas processing
- Electric power production from gas
- Gas distribution, and
- Electric power regulatory best practices.

The program will expose the delegation to U.S. companies with products, services and technologies that can competitively respond to up-coming procurements in the gas sector. It will also include a **one-day business briefing in Houston (Monday, February 27)** and a visit to Washington, DC to meet with relevant gas sector agencies, industry associations and companies.
